



# Non-Fire Temporary Seasonal Employment with the Bureau of Land Management in Idaho Vacancies Open: 01/07/13 - Close: 8/31/13


The following positions are being advertised in multiple locations throughout Idaho. Positions in each location may or may not be filled and are contingent on funding, hiring needs and workload requirements.

## Organization Information

The BLM manages more land – 253 million acres – than any other Federal agency. This land, known as the National System of Public Lands, is primarily located in 12 Western states, including Alaska. The Bureau, with a budget of about \$1 billion also administers 700 million acres of sub-surface mineral estates throughout the nation. The BLM’s multiple-use mission is to sustain the health and productivity of the public lands for the use and enjoyment of present and future generations.

Length of the appointment varies depending on workload requirements and/or funding and cannot exceed 1039 hours, excluding overtime and training, in a service year.

## Requirements

All applicants must be United States citizens and at least 18 years of age by the time of appointment. Applicants with experience or training in the fields for which they are applying may qualify at higher grades. All positions require the applicant to pass a physical examination. All applicants will be considered without regard to political, religious, or labor organization affiliation or non-affiliation, marital status, race, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, non-disqualifying physical or mental disability or age.



## How to Apply:

Click on the button "*Apply Online*" within the vacancy announcement posting and login to USAJOBS.

If you haven't already registered with USAJOBS, the system will require you to create a username and password, complete a questionnaire and build or upload a résumé into USAJOBS.

If you have already registered with USAJOBS and do not know your login credentials, select the "*Forgot your Username and/or Password?*" link from the login menu.

Please conduct the following procedures for your application to be considered for a vacancy:

1. COMPLETE THE ONLINE APPLICATION before the cutoff dates and/or closing dates of the vacancy announcements at the USAJOBS website. The cutoff dates are provided in "REQUIRED DOCUMENTS" section of each vacancy announcement.
2. Fax or upload copies of supplemental application documents (DD-214, transcripts, etc.). Remember to fax or upload all supporting documentation using the upload feature or Auto-Requested Fax feature described in the REQUIRED DOCUMENTS section of each vacancy announcement. Copies of the applicable documents must be submitted for each vacancy that you apply for.

Applications (résumé, application questions) for these vacancies MUST be received online via the USAJOBS website by 11:59 PM Eastern Standard Time on the cutoff date and/or the closing date of the vacancy announcement; please note the cutoff dates for each respective month.



Supplemental application documents must also be uploaded or faxed by 11:59 PM Eastern Standard Time on the cutoff date and/or the closing dates of the vacancy announcement.

## What to Expect Next:

All temporary seasonal vacancies are designed to collect applicant names for these announcements. There are no specific vacant positions waiting to be filled. A list of candidates is only used if and when a manager determines the need to hire an applicant for a position(s).

Applications are not routinely processed until a manager requests a list of candidates. Until such time, applications are on hold pending management decisions to hire applicants.
