



Seasonal FIRE Employment with the Bureau of Land Management in Idaho 2016

The BLM manages more land – approximately 253 million acres - than any other Federal agency. This land, known as the National System of Public Lands, is primarily located in 12 Western states, including Alaska. The Bureau, with a budget of about \$1 billion, also administers 700 million acres of sub-surface mineral estates throughout the nation. The BLM's multiple-use mission is to sustain the health and productivity of the public lands for the use and enjoyment of present and future generations.

Note: Many announcements have early cut-off dates in January 2016 - applicants must apply on or before the cut-off date to receive early consideration. Please refer to each announcement for specific information on cut-off dates. Thereafter, applications may be considered as needed during the remaining open period of the announcement.

Pay

Most temporary positions are paid via General Schedule (GS) grades, GS-2 through GS-7 or via Wage Grade (WG), WG-3 through WG-10. The hourly rates for 2016 are not expected to increase from the 2015 rates for Idaho which are as follows:

Requirements

All applicants must be a United States citizen and at least 18 years of age by the time of appointment. Applicants with

experience or training in the fields for which they are applying may qualify at higher grades.

All positions require the applicant to pass a physical examination and drug test. All applicants will be considered without regard to political, religious, or labor organization affiliation or non-affiliation, marital status, race, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, non-disqualifying physical or mental disability, or age.
