- Resource Foreman (\$14.31 - \$15.87)
- Resource Aide II (\$11.82 - \$12.70)
- Resource Aide I (\$10.65 - \$11.82)

General Information:

- These Firefighting positions are temporary and seasonal (Most positions late May - through August or October). Actual dates vary 3 - 8 months dependent upon weather and employees availability.
- Housing may be available.
- All Individuals will be required to have appropriate clothing including 8" leather non-steel toe work boots with non-skid soles.
- Must be able to pass arduous physical fitness requirements for fire suppression activity (Pack Test).
- Midseason applicants must be qualified fire fighter type II.

Resource Foreman Responsibilities (Fire Crew Supervisor)

Fire Management:

Individual will supervise and train Resource Aide I and II personnel in the preparation for wildland fire suppression, and hazard management projects. They must have a good knowledge of GPS application and data recording. They shall also possess some knowledge of computer processing and applications. Incident Command System qualified as a Single Resource Boss or greater.

Minimum Qualifications:

Candidate must be able to meet the minimum requirements for a Resource Aide II. Possess a valid driver's license. Have a high school diploma or GED, and have the ability to work in adverse conditions for extended periods of time. The candidate must also have 12 months previous experience in a resource related field OR one season previous experience and 2 years of college education in a resource related field.

Resource Aide II (A Trained member of a fire crew).

Fire Management:

Assists in wildland fire suppression and hazard management projects. Capable of performing all tasks required of a Resource Aide I independently, typically Incident Command System qualified as a Firefighter Type II or greater, has had previous experience in wildland firefighting, capable of being a Type 5 wildland fire initial attack incident commander, and able to independently document and prepare accurate fire suppression reports. Able to assist in training others in wildland fire suppression tactics, engine operations, water handling, ignition operations, communications and radio usage, and wildland fire safety. May be required to supervise others on wildland firefighting or hazard management activities. Candidate should have some knowledge of computer processing and usage.

Minimum Qualifications:

In addition to meeting the qualifications as a Resource Aide I, applicant must be at least 18 years old, possess a valid driver's license, and have a minimum of six months of experience with the Idaho Department of Lands OR comparable work experience and/or a minimum one year of college or comparable education in resource related field.

Resource Aide I (Entry level position as a member of a fire crew).

Fire Management:

Assists in wildland fire suppression operations and hazard management projects. Able to learn how to operate, maintain and repair wildland fire suppression equipment such as wildland fire engines, water handling equipment, chainsaws, and hand equipment; and be able to construct fire lines. Capable of learning a basic knowledge of wildland fire suppression tactics, fire behavior, and fuel reduction techniques. Assists in ignition operations, inventorying project areas to determine fuel loadings, installation and removal of water handling equipment, monitoring project areas for fire behavior and fire escapes, and suppressing fire escapes on hazard management projects. Falling hazard trees and snags may be required.

Minimum Qualifications:

Applicant must be at least 18 years old, possess a valid driver's license, be able to read, write, and communicate effectively; to perform strenuous work for extended periods of time; and able to learn use of radio, maps, and resource management equipment.
