**COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This course provides description and detail of the Incident Command System (ICS) organization and operations in supervisory roles on expanding or Type 3 incidents. Topics include ICS fundamentals review, incident/event assessment and agency guidance in establishing incident objectives, Unified Command, incident resource management, planning process, demobilization, transfer of command, and closeout.

**OBJECTIVES**

Describe how the National Incident Management System (NIMS) Command and management component supports the management of expanding incidents. Describe the incident/event management process for supervisors and expanding incidents as prescribed by the ICS. Implement the incident management process on a simulated Type 3 incident. Develop and Incident Action Plan (IAP) for a simulated incident.
