

ANNUAL FIRELINE SAFETY REFRESHER TRAINING

4 Hours

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Course will cover a review of Wildland Fire Safety Principles, including entrapment avoidance, fire shelter use, hazards and safety issues, and current fire issues. Emphasis will be placed on class discussion and interaction. This course will satisfy annual recurrent training requirements for fire personnel.

Those holding Incident Command System qualifications requiring annual fireline safety refresher training per the PMS 310-1 or the FSH 5109.17. Check with your training representative if you need clarification.
