### TRAINING SIGN UP PROCEDURES

- These procedures are for the following classes/sessions only: WCT, Fireline Safety Refresher, Defensive Driving, and First Aid/CPR.
- **Click on the title of the training in the charts below and complete the Google Form to ENROLL.**
- **ALL personnel including FIRE, must use this procedure to guarantee your or your employees spot.** This allows for number tracking, ensure enough pack vests are available as they are limited, classroom has enough seats and build rosters.
- There are specific dates that FIRE staff personnel are the priority due to the scheduled training weeks.

*NOTE for Boise District Fire Supervisors: These four-core training classes listed here and offered by our program, are the only ones you will have to enroll yourself and your crew. The other training offered during the orientation weeks do not require registration. Full agendas for the week of April 18<sup>th</sup> (CS Mandatory Training Week) and the week of May 16<sup>th</sup> (Orientation Week) will be emailed to you.*

### WILDLAND FIRE SAFETY REFRESHER

LOCATION: Expanded Dispatch Room at Boise Interagency Dispatch Center/Boise BLM Fire Office  
3948 S Development Avenue, Boise, ID 83705

**Refer to charts below for start times as they have changed from the past.**

Refresher Training is required every year by anyone who wants to receive a qualification card and/or is a driver for logistics. General fire safety, entrapment avoidance, current issues and fire shelter use will be discussed. Also be prepared to practice fire shelter use.

### WORK CAPACITY TEST

NEW LOCATION: Marianne Williams Park parking area near the restrooms, 3451 E Barber Valley Drive, Boise

- Traveling east from E Parkcenter Blvd and S Bowns Way, cross over the Boise River, then right on E Barber Valley Drive
- Traveling west from Ekert and Warm Springs Avenue intersection, stay right onto Warm Springs Ave, at the round-about take E Parkcenter Blvd, then left on E Barber Valley Drive

**Refer to charts below for start times as they have changed from the past.**

The Work Capacity Test must be completed every year to maintain incident fireline qualifications. *You may only test at the level (arduous, moderate, or light) required for the qualifications that are on your Incident Qualifications Card.*

- *Agency personnel – Must be medically cleared PRIOR to WCT day and also successfully complete the HSQ on the test day. If you are a non-Boise District employee you will need written verification that you are cleared to take the WCT.*
- *AD personnel – Must successfully complete the HSQ the day of the WCT*
