- DESCRIPTION:** This course provides students with the skills to perform as an Expanded Dispatch Recorder EDRC. Topics include the structure of expanded dispatch organization, resource ordering and statusing process; and the importance of communication skills and working relationships. Students will work through scenario based exercises. Included in this course is basic instruction on how to use the Resource Ordering & Status System ROSS.
- NOTE: Class size will be limited to 16 STUDENTS with local personnel taking priority. Another session will be offered Spring 2019 Dates TBD**
- TARGET GROUP:** Individuals who have no previous or limited experience in the dispatch function and who also might assist in an expanded dispatch organization.
- PREREQUISITES:** *Those individuals who have not completed IS100/ICS100 and IS700 are encouraged to complete the training prior to this class.*
- PREWORK:** If selected to attend this course, instructions will be sent in the selection letter on how to set up your ROSS account in NAP which is required to perform the exercises. *Computers will be provided.*
